

Title of the activity: Where am I sung?

For who: 7 to 99999 years Duration: 90 mn (2x45min) Number of players: 10 In 4 teams maximum

Place: anywhere

Characteristic:

- cheap
- can be played everywhere, players just need to can write.

Type of game: Blind test

Educational interest:Discover the world music

Materials:

- Computer
- Speaker
- World map
- Color papper

Goal:

Confront the preconceptions and knowledge of the world the participants could have. Invite them to exchange about their musical knowledge and share their discoveries.


Method:

Prepare a musical selection including a large range of cultural backgrounds (regional and ethnic) and rank it. Invite (if possible) participants to bring 1 music (3 minutes maximum) important to them and representing their membership or their state of mind.

The game will take place in the form of a "blind test" for 45 minutes and participants will be divided into a maximum of 4 teams.

To start, the animator will broadcast his own music into categories. Each team will try to find quickly the origins (regional, ethnic) of the music, and if possible the group or singer to win more points. Responses should beings rated on 3 differents colored papers depending on the category, the first correct answer gives point to the team, the following teams with the right answer wins half points, and so on.

- Ø 1 point Country of origin (pink paper)
- Ø 1 point Region (Blue Paper)
- Ø 1 point Singer or Group (Green Paper)





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Give the results after each music and noted the points music after music.

Give the results at the end of the game and congratulate the participants, then, explain to them the purpose of that time was not to win at or lose, but to discover new sets (or not) of musical cultures.

Place the guests in a circle and play their music one after the other, it will be the opportunity for them to know more their friends. The players should describe the emotions this music procures to their and creat a « mini debate ». The person who made the music that will close the conversation by explaining their choice and what inspires her music.
