



Title of the activity: Intercultural Party

For who: 14+

Duration: 2h+

Number of persons: 6+

Place: Outside/inside

Characteristic:

- Learn new things
- Make new friends
- Intercultural

Type: multicultural activity

Educational interest:

- Learn new things about other cultures
- Make new friends
- Exercise your language skills

Materials:

1. Specific, traditional food and drinks
2. Traditional music

Goal: The purpose of this activity is to make new friends and learn about other cultures and diversity in a non-formal way and by having fun in the same time.

Method:

1. First you need a space where to organize the party and some friends to help you with their support.
2. The easiest way to organize an intercultural party is to make a facebook event and to invite persons from your community and search for Erasmus students in your city or European Volunteers came with EVS in your city, usually there are specific facebook groups and you can invite them to the party. If in your city are not foreign persons you can invite locals that came from other parts or have other ethnic backgrounds.
3. In the description of the event you can invite people to bring some traditional food or drink to share. Also they can bring some traditional music and teach people to dance, or some short movies about their countries/culture.
4. Don't worry that people will not come, because many persons want to meet new friends and to learn about other cultures and to share theirs. This kind of meetings makes communities stronger, more open and friendly.
