

Title of the activity : Video shot

For who : 13+ Duration : 60 – 90 min Number of players : 6 and more Place : inside

Characteristic :

- social problems
- argumentation

Type of game : social problems

Educational interest :

- development opinions and knowledges of social problems
- development of argumentation
- support of initiative

Materials :

- papers and pens for brainstorming,
- pc or laptops for finding information
- video camera

Goal : Development opinions and knowledges of social problems, development of argumentation

Method :

- 1. At the first we will start with brainstorming in group of participants. The question for brainstorming is: What have we social problems? Participants through ideas and we write it (on a board or flipchart).
- 2. Than we split the group to small groups (min. 3; max 5 participants). You can use special game or just numbers one, two, three...
- 3. Each small group should choose one social problem on the board. The specific social problem can have just one group.
- 4. Now the small group start to work on the topic (specific social problem). The first step work in the group is brainstorming about the topic it can be answer for question What do we know about this kind topic? Participants can discuss in their group, they can try to find way of the topic,...

The second step is – try to find information about the topic. They can use pc or laptops for finding information.

The third step is – try to make video shot about the topic. They should try to make video shot like promotion of the topic. The spot should call topic. As leader you can show them video spots from UNICEF (or another). The spot should be short 1-3 minutes.

- 5. If they finished, we can start with presentation of the video spots. Each group show us their video spot. These spots we can shoot.
- 6. In the end you should make evaluation.
